Subject: Four-way Stop Sign at 19th Street and Peninah Street

Attached is Resolution No. 08-07 which if approved would establish a four-way stop condition at the intersection of 19th Street and Peninah Street.

A detailed survey was conducted associated with the Peninah Street reconstruction project by Johnson Engineering Co. The survey revealed that the site distance is restricted enough to warrant the use of a four-way stop to improve roadway safety at this location. The recommendation to stop the north-south traffic, in addition to the east-west traffic which is already a stop condition, is in conformance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

Based on the information provided by Johnson Engineering Co. and warrants outlined in the MUTCD, City staff recommends that a four-way stop be installed at the intersection of 19th Street and Peninah Street.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF A FOUR-WAY STOP
SIGN APPLICATION AT THE INTERSECTION OF
19TH STREET AND PENINAH STREET.**

WHEREAS, conditions at the intersection of 19th Street and Peninah Street justify that traffic from all four directions come to a stop and;

WHEREAS, the installation of a four-way stop would increase the safety of pedestrian and vehicle traffic, and;

WHEREAS, it is provided by the Code of Ordinances of the City of Yankton that the City has the authority to place and maintain all regulatory signs that meet the requirements of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Yankton, SD, that a four-way stop sign condition be established at the intersection of 19th Street and Peninah Street.
