Attached is Resolution #08-26 which if approved would establish a stop condition for east bound traffic at the intersection of Applewood Drive and Peninah Street.

The acceptance of Applewood Drive, a local street, into the City of Yankton's transportation system has created a tee intersection with Peninah Street. The north-south Peninah Street is a principal arterial and carries a high volume of traffic. The recommendation to stop the east bound traffic on Applewood is in conformance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

Based on the information provided and the warrants outlined in the MUTCD, City staff recommends that a stop sign be installed on Applewood Drive at the intersection of Peninah Street.
