One (1) bid was received on February 16, 2009 for the Annual Supply of Liquid Asphalt as illustrated below:


- The bid for the AC Grade Asphalt was from Jebro, Inc. of Sioux City, Iowa, in the amount of \$547.25 per ton.
- The bid for the MC Grade Asphalt was from Jebro, Inc. of Sioux City, Iowa, in the amount of \$2.8175 per gallon.
- The bid for the RC Grade Asphalt was from Jebro, Inc. of Sioux City, Iowa, in the amount of \$2.7225 per gallon.

The above grades of asphalt are those used by the City to complete its annual maintenance and reconstruction of streets. Bid prices reflect an increase over last year's prices, most notably is AC Grade Asphalt with an increase of \$129.65 per ton. Other increases are as follows: MC Grade Asphalt with an increase of \$.2975 per gallon and the RC Grade Asphalt with an increase of .3475 per gallon.

It is recommended that the bid be awarded to Jebro, Inc. of Sioux City, Iowa, for the AC Grade Asphalt, RC Grade Asphalt and MC Grade Asphalt in the amounts stated above.

I have discussed this recommendation with the Director of Public Services and have received his concurrence on this matter.


