**Subject:** Bid Award for the Mulberry Street Water Main and Street Reconstruction Project from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 15<sup>th</sup> Street.  
**Date:** April 20, 2009

Construction contract bids for the 2009 Mulberry Street reconstruction project were received on April 17, 2009. This project involves the installation of water main, aggregate base course and curb and gutter from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 15<sup>th</sup> Street.

The bids received are listed below:

1. LRC, Inc., Spicer, MN	\$332,579.55
2. Lidel Construction, Chester, SD	\$361,308.07
3. Feimer Construction, Yankton, SD	\$366,245.80
4. First Rate Excavate, Sioux Falls, SD	\$378,705.84
5. Slowey Construction, Yankton, SD	\$385,551.50
6. Prunty Construction Co., Brookings, SD	\$393,286.94

LRC, Inc. has worked for the City of Yankton in the past. They were the contractor for the Pearl Street project last year. The project included the installation of a 16" water main, storm sewer and PCC pavement. Just short of a year, there have been no problems with the workmanship of the final product.

The low bid is competitive and meets the specifications. City staff recommends that the bid be awarded, subject to the concurrence of the South Dakota Department of Environmental & Natural Resources, to LRC, Inc. for \$332,579.55.


