Subject: Resolution No. 10-21 Establishing Parking Restriction on the West Side of Broadway Avenue North of 2nd Street
Date: June 23, 2010

Attached is a Resolution #10-21 that would eliminate parking on the west side of Broadway Avenue (Hwy 81) from the centerline of 2nd Street going north 300 feet to a point that coincides with the north side of a City owned public parking lot. This parking restriction would eliminate seven existing parking stalls on Broadway Avenue.

The Resolution has been prepared for the City Commission under the direction of the South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT). DOT traffic engineers reviewed the intersection and specified the length of the proposed "no parking" zone. They indicated that the request is recommended to improve the sight distance at the 2nd Street and Highway 81 intersection.

Copies of this memorandum and resolution were provided to the occupants of the adjacent property.

**ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF BROADWAY AVENUE
NORTH OF 2ND STREET**

A “No Parking” zone be designated and marked for the west side of Broadway from the center line of 2nd Street going north 300 feet to a point that coincides with the north property line of the City owned parking lot.
