The sewer main extension for the Chalkstone Hill Addition has been completed and the owners are now asking these improvements be accepted. The improvements consist of 300 linear feet of 8-inch sewer main and a manhole, all located on the west side of West City Limits Road, just south of 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

The sewer line was constructed several years ago but was never accepted because of grade issues. The contractor has since returned and the issues have been addressed. Along with the City, Arens Engineering has reviewed the changes and recommends approval. The one year warranty will apply from the date of the City's final acceptance.

It is recommended that the City Commission accept the new sewer improvements as described above.
